Safety Precautions

Read the manual before use.

Warning: in order to avoid causing harm to you and others and causing unnecessary property damage, read carefully and observe the following "safety precautions" before use. The safety precautions are divided into two parts: "Warning" and "Attention". Both "Warning" and "Attention" are important parts of safe use. Be sure to follow them.



Marning Notices that can lead to death or serious injury when not following the instructions



Attention Notices that can lead to slight injury or product safety risk



Warning

- 1. Do not use this product near wet places such as the bathroom.
- 2. Do not use on cleaning liquids, matches and damp rubbish.
- 3. Do not unplug / plug in or contact the adapter socket with wet hand.
- 4. Do not use broken power plug and loose socket.
- 5. Do not use the vacuum cleaner to clean kerosene, gasoline and other flammable liquids and objects with spark, cartridge, toner and other combustible dust or use the vacuum cleaner near the above items and in inflammable and explosive gases, so as not to cause fire.
- 6. Do not disassemble, repair or transform by yourself to avoid fire, injury or improper operation, except certified replacement of consumables according to this manual.
- 7. Use AC power at rated voltage, do not use generator or DC power supply, etc., to avoid causing fire and electric shock.
- 8. Regularly use dry cleaning cloth to clean the dust on the plug, so as to avoid fire due to poor insulation and other reasons.
- 9. Make sure that the plug is well inserted in the bottom to avoid electric shock, short circuit and fire.
- 10. In case of any abnormal failure, stop using it immediately to avoid causing smoke, fire and electric shock.
- 11. When in following conditions, such as body distortion, unusual heating, smell of burning and there is any abnormal sound during operation, immediately cut off the power supply and unplug the plug, place the product in an open and non-combustible area, ensure the safety and the manufacturer or its maintenance staff shall replace and repair it to avoid any danger.
- 12. Be sure to remove the plug from the power socket before cleaning and maintenance to avoid electric shock and injury.
- 13. If the electric brush is found to be abnormal in use, turn off the power switch and immediately check whether the electric brush is wrapped around the hair or other excessively long fibers, and clean it in time.
- 14. Do not pour water on the body of the machine and plug or immerse the body and/or plug into water.
- 15. Do not charge the vacuum cleaner with other adapter.
- 16. Hold the plug when unplugging it. Do not pull it from the power cord.
- 17. Keep all parts of the body, such as hair, loose clothes and fingers, away from each end of the interface and the mouth of the roller brush.
- 18. Do not operate the vacuum facing the ears, eyes, mouth and other body parts.
- 19. The battery is a sealed device that normally has no safety hazards. In extreme cases, liquid comes out of the battery, which may cause irritation or burns. In case of accidental contact, follow the following precautions: If it touches the skin --wash with soapy water; if eyes contact it—immediately rinse with water for at least 15minutes and seek medical help.
- 20. This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.

- 24. The charger must not be used if the enclosure is damaged because this will cause hazard of electric shock.

- 29. Do not continue to use the appliance in such cases: drop, impact by a heavy object, other means of damage etc.



If it occurs, get the charger, repaired by our service agent.

- 30. Do not disassemble the battery charger by yourself to avoid fire hazard or electric shock.
- 31. Remove the plug from the socket before cleaning or maintaining the charger.
- 32.Do not try to charge non-rechargeable batteries with this charger.
- 33. When the vacuum cleaner is attached to the magnetic wall mount, do not let children or pets collide with it to avoid damage.
- 34.Before discarding the vacuum cleaner, make sure that the battery is removed from the appliance.
- 35. Before removing the battery, be sure to turn off the vacuum cleaner before operating.




- 1. Do not run for a long time when the vacuum cleaner is blocked.
- 2. Do not block the vent (to avoid deformation to the body of the machine, failure or fire caused by overheating).
- 3. Do not drag and drop the body of the machine (to avoid scratching the ground).
- 4. Do not wave the body of the machine. Do not let children play with it, etc (to avoid injury or damage).
- 5 . Do not drop the product into other objects and apply pressure to the product (to avoid fire and electric shock caused by failure).
- 6. Be sure to install the dust cup before using it (to avoid motor damage).
- 7. Check whether the adapter charging cord is in good condition before charging.
- 8. Before using the vacuum cleaner for the first time or replacing the specified filter element, turn off the power of the vacuum cleaner and ensure that the filter element is installed in place.
- 9. When there is a lot of garbage in the dust cup, clean it at that time to ensure unimpeded ventilation path, so as to avoid blocking, resulting in reduced suction or heating of the motor.
- 10. The waste battery pack should be recycled safely. Do not throw it away just anywhere.
- 11. Do not draw large, soft, sticky objects such as wool, hair, bulk cotton, dough, and chewing gum into the vacuum cleaner.
- 12. Use the vacuum cleaner to clean the stairs with special care so as not to fall down.
- 13. Be sure that the vacuum cleaner power is turned off when the electric brush and accessories are reconnected or disconnected.



Product Installation

Vacuum Cleaner Installation

Step 1. Insert the end with release button of the electric brush into the corresponding port of the metal connecting rod vertically as shown in the figure, until it clicks into the right position.

Step 2. Insert the end with release button of the metal connecting rod into the corresponding port of the main machine vertically, until it clicks into the right position.





Attention

1.Be careful when installing electric brush to avoid gripping hand.

2.Before installing the electric brush, make sure the metal contact is clean and dry, to avoid unnecessary damage caused by short circuit during use due to insufficient connection or water.

Installation of Accessories

For the convenience of use, this product is specially equipped with accessories for the main machine of the vacuum cleaner. When the main machine of the vacuum cleaner is used separately, it can be connected to the accessories directly as required.

1. Connection of flat cleaner head: insert the end with release button of the flat cleaner head into the corresponding port of the main machine, until it clicks into right position.



2. Sofa Brush Installation: Put the sofa brush flat mouth upward, insert into the flat cleaner head along the direction shown below vertically, until it clicks into right position.



Tips:


The attachment of the vacuum cleaner main machine can be directly connected with the stretch soft hose and the mattress brush. The connection mode is the same as that of the flat cleaner head. Sofa brush can also be directly connected to the stretch soft hose, and the connection mode is the same as flat cleaner head connection mode.

Installation of Fittings

Installation of Wall-fixed Cordless Charging Box

Method 1: Nailing installation of wall-fixed charging box

When installing wall-fixed charging box, please contact the charging box contact with the contact of host first. After moving the host to the wall of charging box, compare the installation hole position of charging box, then insert the expansion pipe and expansion screw in turn. (When using the screws to fix wall-fixed charging box, please do not take off glue-separating paper and use it as reserved screw-free installation.)

Method 2: Screw-free installation of wall-fixed charging box

When installing the wall-fixed charging box, please first measure the height of 92 cm from the ground, remove the foam cotton glue-separating paper from the wall-fixed charging box, and stick the charging socket of the wall-fixed charging box downward at the measured position.

Recommended for use on glass and ceramic walls; keep the walls clean before installing, no dirt, impurities, etc.

Fixing of Vacuum Cleaner

1. Place the electric brush horizontally on the ground.

2. Move the vacuum cleaner main machine to adhere to fully adheres to the wall-fixed charging box.






- 1. When placing the main machine, please remove the water tank module first, so as to avoid the sliding of the main machine when the electric ground brush tilts.
- 2. When the main body is placed to the wall suction fixing box, keep children and pets away from the vacuum to avoid bumping and potential damage.
- 3. Move the main machine horizontally to adhere to fully adheres to the wall-fixed charging box, in order to avoid the occurrence of dumping injuries of main machine due to unfixed magnetic suction.
- 4. Make sure that the power indicator LED lights up when charging the main machine to ensure that charging is in progress.

Product Usage

Power On/Off and Suction Power Switch

Press on the button of the power switch for 1 second to start the machine in normal mode.

During operation state, click the shift button or power switch button, and the suction power will switch among the normal mode, high speed mode and powerful mode.



Adapter Usage

1. Fix the charging cable

Before charging, make sure that the adapter is connected to the rated AC power supply. The DC metal charging socket is inserted into the charging hole at bottom of wall-fixed charging box.

2. Charge

Attach the main machine to the wall-fixed charging box, if the charging indicator light increases successively according to the power condition, it indicates that the vacuum cleaner is charging, and when the indicator light is fully on, the vacuum cleaner battery is full.





1. Carbon fiber rolling brush can be used for floor tile, floor and undercoat carpet.



2. Soft velvet rolling brush can be used for floor tile,wooden floor and polish its surface. It is not recommended to clean carpet as shown in the image below.






Attention

- 3.Ensure installation in place, no parts missing when replace brushes.


Tips: When LED lamp works on the dark corner, it will be on and adjust the light automatically, easy and convenient.

Usage of Accessories


1. Flat cleaner head: use for cleaning doors and windows, stairs and other narrow gaps.




2. Stretch soft hose: use for hard-to-reach corner cleaning.



3. Electric Mattress Brush: Use for removing dust and mite on the bed, curtain and other home textiles.



4. Multifunctional Brush (Used with flat cleaner head): Use for cleaning dust of sofa, seat, cloest, window and the dust adhered to the furniture surface.





Attention

- 2. Please keep kids away from electric mattress brush during using.
- 3. Please do not use electric mattress brush to suck little cloth, in case of blocking.
- 4. Please empty drawer first to avoid device damage when using stretch soft hose to clean drawer.
- 5. Please clean the vauum accessories after each use, for keeping food residue, cotton fiber long time in the accessories will make them rot resulting in device damage.

Product Cleaning

Removal and Installation of the Dust Cup

Step 1: Remove the dust cup

Press the release button of the dust cup, pull the dust cup horizontally to the right.






Turn over the dust cup and rotate the cyclone to clean . If necessary, remove the filter to clean up the dust.



Step 3: Installation instruction of cyclone, dust cup and filter Align the cyclone and the dust cup to the clamp position according to the position shown in the figure, and rotate clockwise until you hear it clicks. When installing the filter element of the dust cup, please align the orange point to the rib position, the dotted line position as shown in the figure, to ensure that the magnet is within the induction range.




Step 4: Installation instruction of the dust cup Click the anti-off button, insert the dust cup counterclockwise as the below image shows until you hear it clicks.



Removal and Installation Instruction of the Rear Filter

Step 1: Remove the motor tail cover Align the tip of the cleaner brush to the opening slot of the motor tail cover, press slightly in the vertical direction, lift the tail cover of the motor, and remove it.





Step 2: Remove the rear filter

Pull up the handle rear filter to remove it.

Step 3: Install the rear filter
Install the rear filter into the limit area of the tail cover of the motor
and press it to the locking position.



Step 4: Install the motor tail cover Press tail cover slightly until you hear it clicks.





- 1. Turn off the power of the vacuum cleaner before cleaning.
- 2. When cleaning, point the dust cup at the garbage can for dis-assembly.
- 3. Do not install the dust cup when it is wet.
- 4. Do not forget to install the dust cup filter element, when installing the filter, install it in the corresponding magnetic position of dust cup.
- 5. When installing the cyclone, please align to the clamp position and rotate for installation. Do not force or press to install.
- 6. When installing the dust cup, make sure that the dust cup anti-off button has been installed in the right place to avoid falling and damaging foot or floor.

Component Cleaning

Step 1: Cyclone cleaning

Take out the cyclone first and then clean the dust and hairs attached in the metal mesh and the duct.



Step 3: Filter element cleaning

Take out the filter element, clean suspended dust with a cleaner brush. If necessary, replace the specified dust cup filter element. It is recommended to replace the specified filter element every 3 months to ensure cleanness.




Step 2: Dust cup and metal mesh cleaning

Clean the dust cup and metal mesh with water and use after drying in case dust caking.



Step 4: Back part element cleaning

Take out the back part filter element, clean suspended dust with a clean brush. If necessary, replace the specified back part filter element. It is recommended to clean every 6 months and replace it every year to ensure cleanness.








- 1. Do not drag the dust separator of cyclone mechanism forcibly to avoid damaging to the metal mesh.
- 2. Dry naturally after washing to avoid corrosion.
- 3. Please use the original dust cup and filter to avoid the damage to the vacuum cleaner.
- 4. Please use the original cleaner brush to clean the dust cup filter element. Do not use steel brushes or other high strength brushes to cleaning. 5. When cleaning the back part element, please clean along the direction of the filter mesh, do not clean along other directions, in order to avoid damage to the back part element.
- 6. Do not wash the back part filter element with water.


Rolling Brush Replacement

Step 1: Remove the rolling brush

Place the electric brush upside down, press the rolling brush release button, to remove the rolling brush fixing block,remove the rolling brush to clean the surface dirty stuff.









Attention

1.Turn off the power when replacing the rolling brush.

2.The cleaner brush has a sharp blade, which is used to cut off any entanglement stuff around the brush. Children should not be exposed to use the cleaner brush.

3.Do not forget to fixed the block after place the rolling brush, do not use electric brush without block fixed.
